CA	CA High Cost Fund A	Intrastate end user revenue	Provides a source of supplemental revenues to 17 small local exchange carriers (LECs) for the purpose of minimizing any rate disparity of basic telephone services between rural and metropolitan areas.
CA	CA High Cost Fund B	Intrastate end user revenue	Provides subsidies to carriers of last resort (COLRs) for providing basic local telephone service to residential customers in high-cost areas that are currently served by Pacific Bell, Verizon California Inc., Citizens Telecommunications of California, and SureWest.
CA	Relay Service and Communications Device Funds (DEAF)	Intrastate end user revenue	Provides services and equipment to deaf, hearing-impaired, and consumers with vision, mobility, speech and cognitive disabilities.
CA	CA Teleconnect Fund	Intrastate end user revenue	provides discounted telecommunications services for qualifying schools, libraries, hospitals, and community-based organizations.
CA	Universal Lifeline Telephone Service (ULTS)	Intrastate end user revenue	Provides discounted basic residential telephone services to low-income households.
CA municipalities	Utility user taxes of municipal jurisdictions that have established such taxes	Varies-primarily intrastate end user revenue	Remitted to general fund of municipal authorities
FCC	Federal Telecommunications Relay Fund	Interstate & International end user revenues (Billed at zero rate by Arrival)	Supports telecommunicaitons for speech & hearing impaired individuals-not assessed as line item on Arrival bills (subsumed in RCAF)
FCC	FCC Common Carrier Regulatory Fee (Form FCC 159)	Interstate & International end user revenues (Not seperately billed by Arrival)	Fee to support FCC-not assessed as line item on Arrival bills (subsumed in RCAF)
FCC	Universal Service Fund (Fed Universal Fee)	Interstate and International revenues (includes interstate usage, per line interstate access fee, and carrier access charge)	Supports universal service by subsidizing telecommunications in high cost areas, to low income subscribers, and in public schools/libraries/hospitals
FCC	NANPA Invoice - Annual Payment	Interstate & International end user revenues (Not seperately billed by Arrival)	Supports the North American Numbering Plan Administration (subsumed in number administration fee)
Federal	Federal Excise Tax ("Federal" on Arrival's bills)	Federal & state telecommunications charges	Remitted to IRS general fund
Arrival	Number Administration Fee	Applied to interstate access & carrier access elements of monthly service charge	Recoups costs to Arrival of telephone number data base development & maintenance
Arrival	Regulatory Compliance Administrative Fee (RCAF)	Applied to interstate usage (LD & 8xx traffic) plus access line charges (EUCL & CAC)	Recoups cost to Arrival of collection, reporting, remittance and general administration of government fees and taxes
Arrival	Carrier Access Charge	Fixed per line/per month charge	Recoups cost to Arrival of access to long distance carriers' networks
